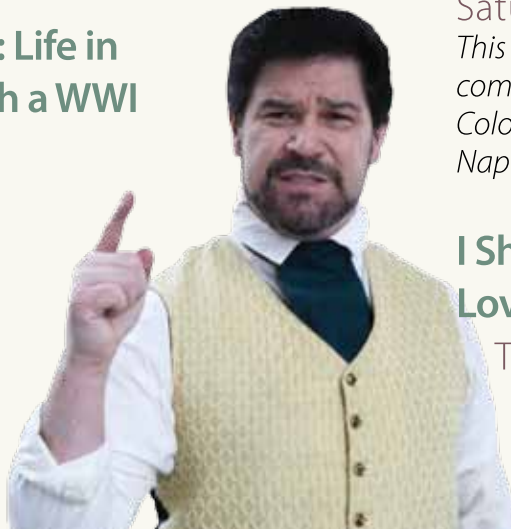
Historical characters come to life in one- or two-person plays. These FREE 20-minute programs are held in the MacDermott Grand Hall.

*Experience the highs and lows of a woman's life in the age of steam.*

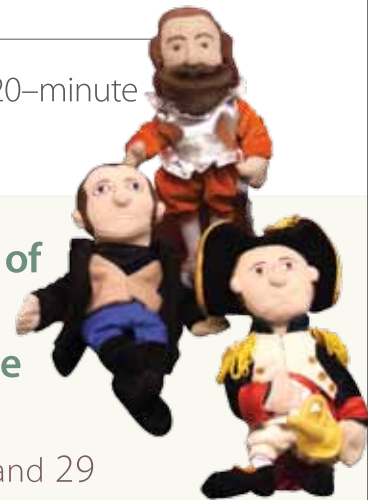
### In Flanders Field: Life in the Trenches with a WWI Doughboy
