Objective: To provide one-on-one attention to museum guests and support to MHM staff.

Responsibilities:

Provide one-on-one attention to visitors and gallery exhibits.

Engage visitors through visual objects on "touch carts."

Assist walk-in guests.

Attendants are stationed in certain galleries to provide specialized information and attention on topics that relate to the assigned gallery.

Re-set interactive objects in exhibit galleries.

Provide assistance with group management in galleries with large groups.

Assist with scavenger hunts.

Experience and Requirements:

We are looking for individuals with strong verbal communication skills, the ability to speak in front of large groups and interact with a wide range of diverse people. While experience working with the public is desired it is not mandatory. If you like people, like learning, like history and sharing stories then we have a place for you! This position is flexible but requires a commitment of 10 hours **per month**, with shifts ranging from Monday-Sunday 9:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Training:
